Behaviour Policy Updates

The following updates apply from the 15th June to the 16th July. These will be reviewed on a weekly basis. We know the vast majority of our students do not present any concerns. However, we have been advised by National Government and our Trust Governing Body, to include these updates to minimise risk to both staff and pupils.

Our children are welcome at our school and we look forward to seeing them once again.

All Year 10 Pupils attending school on-site must:

1. Remove all PPE (Including face masks and gloves) on entry to the school. Pupils can throw these in the assigned bin or place them in their bags.
2. All pupils must wash their hands with school anti – bacterial foamy soap when instructed to do so (on entry; after bathroom use, before eating, after eating, before departure). Pupils can also use their provided hand sanitisers as well.
3. Pupils must not bring in the following items: bags; stationary; water bottles; junk food items (fizzy drinks, chocolate, unhealthy crisps). Pupils can bring a lunchbox.
4. Pupils must follow staff instructions at all times. Pupils must maintain social distancing throughout the day, including inside the classroom, at break time and whilst moving around the building).
5. Pupils must not be passive attendees. Pupils must contribute effectively in class and communicate with staff with politeness. All classwork must be done to the best of their abilities.
6. Pupils do not need to wear school uniform. But they must wear modest clothing which is fresh and clean for each day they attend.
7. Any pupil suspected of coughing as ‘a joke’ or to cause disruption will be immediately removed. Serious sanctions will follow. As such; and pupil observed spitting or chewing gum will also face serious sanctions.
8. Pupils who are late, may not be given entry and their place withdrawn and offered to another child.
9. Pupils will be given the use of their own set of equipment; water bottle and laptop. They must not share any of these with any other pupil.
